EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3 Series of 2022

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER EXTENDING THE EFFECTIVITY OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1 SERIES OF 2022 IMPLEMENTING THE ALERT LEVEL 3 STATUS IN THE PROVINCE OF BULACAN UNTIL 31 JANUARY 2022

WHEREAS, on 08 March 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued *Proclamation No.* 922 declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines and enjoined all local government units (LGUs) to render full assistance and cooperation to implement urgent and critical measures to contain or prevent the spread of Covid-19, mitigate its effects and impact to the community, and prevent serious disruption of the functioning of the government and the community;

WHEREAS, on 16 March 2020, President Duterte issued *Proclamation No. 929* declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines and placed the entire Island of Luzon under Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ);

WHEREAS, on 29 October 2021, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) placed the Province of Bulacan under COVID-19 Alert Level System;

WHEREAS, on 14 January 2022, the IATF, in its Resolution 157-A, series of 2022, extended the Alert Level 3 status of the province until 31 January 2022;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 465, Par. (b) of the Local Government Code, the Provincial Governor, as the chief executive of the provincial government, is authorized to adopt such emergency measures as may be necessary during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural disasters and calamities, issue such executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances, and ensure that the acts of all LGUs in the province and their officials are within the scope of their prescribed powers, duties, and functions.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DANIEL R. FERNANDO, Provincial Governor of Bulacan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order that the effectivity of *Executive Order No. 1, Series of 2022*, issued on 04 January 2022 shall be extended until midnight of 31 January 2022, unless sooner modified or terminated.
